Yes Watch

This watch is actually a minicomputer designed for astronomers. It has solstice and equinox alerts, the current lunar phase, and it shows in a glance the amount of daylight and nighttime remaining for any given day at any place on the planet. The Yes Watch keeps its wearer in tune with the sky.

The water-resistant, stainless steel watch with Swiss parts has an aquablue light and a stopwatch with a lap-time feature. At first glance, the timepiece may look complicated, but no other watch is so tuned to the cosmos as well as the wearer's personal needs. The watch also comes preprogrammed to tell time for 500 cities worldwide, and adjusts for daylight savings time and can be set for longitude and latitude.
