## Some helpful hints in how to exchange the battery in your oval face YES watch.

Before proceeding on any step in this process make sure to <u>study watch and module</u> <u>with a magnifier</u> to gain understanding of how it is put together. Work on a solid table. Do not use excessive force.

- 1. Unscrew the 4 screws holding back plate in place.
- 2. While holding module firmly inside of case unclasp the battery bracket. Use a pointed tool to release clasp. Do not try to take module out of case. Remove CR2025 battery carefully, while still holding module firmly in case.
- 3. Reinsert a fresh CR2025 into battery slot and lock it in place by snapping the battery holding bracket into place.
- 4. Make sure O-ring is properly seated on back plate, position correctly, it is directional and then screw the 4 screws back onto watchcase. A couple of drops of fine oil smeared on the O-ring first and screws is not a bad idea. Once all 4 screws are in tighten them all firmly
- 5. Push all 4 buttons to test watch functionality. Watch will flash a display, sound the alarm and turn on the back light for 3 seconds.
- 6. If alarm does not sound unscrew back plate again and make sure alarm spring reaches alarm plate. Pull the spring gently outwards to extend it's reach.
- 7. Then set location and time.
